Industry revenue for the childcare services sector is expected to grow by 5.8% annually to reach \$16.4 billion by 2021-22ⁱ. There are more than 10,000 childcare centres in Australia and strong annual growth is expected in the coming yearsⁱ.


JOB SATISFACTION, SALARY & KEY BENEFITS


