NEW MENTAL HEALTH COURSE AVAILABLE IN TOOWOOMBA

Every year approximately one in five Australians will experience a mental illness, and with an increasing demand for skilled workers TAFE Queensland South West is excited to announce that a new mental health course is now open for enrolment in Toowoomba.

The [Certificate IV in Mental Health \(CHC43315\)](#) reflects the role of workers who provide self-directed recovery oriented support for people affected by mental illness and psychiatric disability, and is designed for both existing workers looking to upskill and those wanting to enter the industry.

The first intake for the year long course is scheduled for Semester Two, commencing 10 July 2017, through a blended delivery mode including online study, face-to-face training and vocational placement.
